



INFANT SUPPLY LIST

The following items should be brought to your child's class on their first day of attendance to insure that the day runs as smoothly as possible. Keeping your child's supply of extra clothing, diapers, wipes, etc. current assists the teachers immensely and allows them to care for your child in the most effective manner. Every effort is made to conserve supplies and your child's inventory is checked frequently to make sure you are aware of his/her needs.

- ❑ Unopened package of diapers
- ❑ At least (2) Unopened packages of wipes, preferably unscented
- ❑ 1 Large box of Kleenex
- ❑ Breast Milk/Formula (if not accepting formula provided by Friends)
- ❑ Baby Food (if not accepting food supplied by Friends)
- ❑ A minimum of 2 changes of clothes suitable for current weather conditions, including socks and onesies
- ❑ Any medication, diaper cream, ointment, etc. as designated on your medication order
- ❑ Paperwork
 - Completed Enrollment Record
 - Authorization for Transportation/Sunscreen
 - Physical Exam Record & Immunization Record
 - 1 Copy of Child's Official Birth Certificate
 - Signed Birth Certificate Consent Form
 - Emergency Information Sheet
 - Breast Milk Procedure Form
 - Powdered Formula Policy (With Doctor's Note)
 - Infant Feeding Plan (Signed by Physician)
 - Medication Order (Signed by Physician)
 - Emergency Medical Authorization
 - Emergency Health Information and Medical Plan
